

The list of vehicles most considered at risk for theft is complied from a survey of insurance companies by Insurance Council of New Zealand. It consists of two general types of vehicle. The first is high performance, high value motor vehicles which are often targeted and stolen specifically to order. The second group is relatively inexpensive, high performance vehicles that are seen as joy riding opportunities and are often involved in street racing of some sort or another.

This list is not indicative of any defects in the cars, but simply Insurance Companies concerns about their risk from organised or opportunistic theft.
